March 2000	They open an After School Classes (Konbuban) in Jeonju.
September 2000	A Postulant was accepted. (She left after two months.)
March 2003	Sister Benedette left Korean Mission because of the health reasons.
	The After School Classes (Konbuban) were closed and Joanna
	began Private Japanese teaching and other group activities.
June 30, 2006	The Korean Mission was closed and Joanna returned to Japan.
